Performance Camp

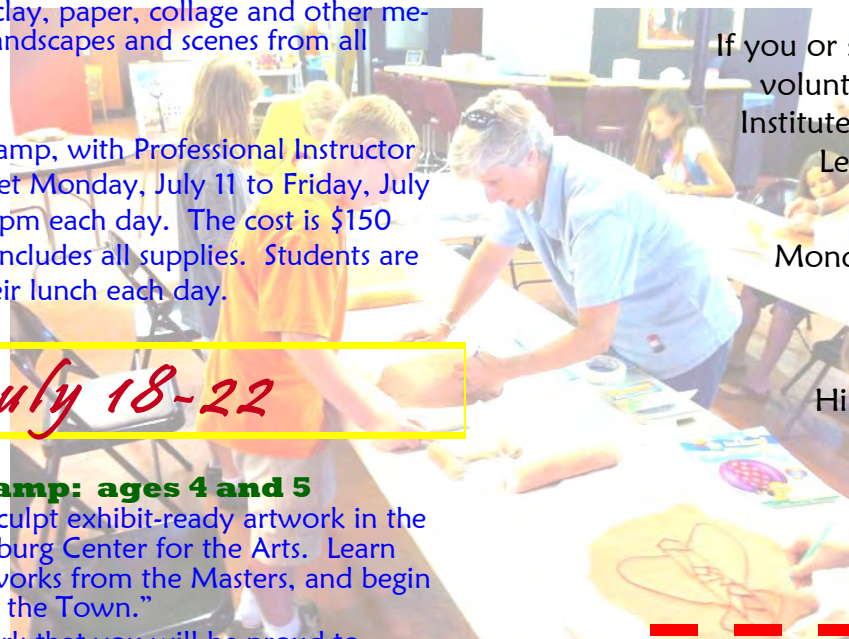

RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND SAFETY AGREEMENT

The Leesburg Center for the Arts is striving to provide a positive and safe experience for all participants in its program. It is for this purpose we feel it is necessary to provide a list of our safety rules for you and/or your student to read and agree to prior to working in the center. If you or your student cannot abide by our safety rules, we will ask you or your student not to participate in our programs. It is our intent to provide the safest working experience possible. We will be careful not to use toxic materials with students and teach students how to use materials and equipment safely.

- Appropriate clothing must be worn for the classes being attended. (i.e. no loose clothing that could be caught or dragged in chemicals, equipment or anything that could cause bodily harm, slippery shoes, or clothing that could be damaged by paint, ink, etc.) A smock is recommended.
- No running in the building
- Students are to attend to their own work and are not to touch another person's work or instrument without special permission.
- Students are not to touch any work on display
- Students are not to play with any equipment or supplies without special permission or instruction.
- Students are to be courteous and respectful of authorities and teachers. They must listen to instructions and ask questions in an appropriate time and way.
- No throwing anything in the building.
- Students are responsible to clean up any work space utilized and return all supplies to their proper place.
- Students are not to remove any supplies from the Center without special permission.
- Students may not wander through the building or down the street during break times without permission.
